THE POST

The Project Executive will cover the North East area, based in the RTC head office in Sunderland but will on occasion be required to visit the other RTC offices and travel to UK and European destinations. The person appointed will be trained in the use of all relevant systems.

Key Responsibilities

- **Build relationships with EEN SME clients and recruit new clients for EEN services** - preparing profiles, following up live expressions of interest as well as conducting searches for business, technological or research proposals that may be relevant. Subsequently to increase the number of interactions with new clients by targeting email campaigns, speaking at/attending events, cold calling, referrals or other strategic activities;



- **Acquire and use expert knowledge to facilitate brokerage and deal-making**, supporting local SMEs to achieve lasting business benefits through collaboration. This will include developing a systematic process to identifying high-value incoming opportunities from EEN partners and supporting local clients in their efforts to both innovate and internationalise;
- **Foster joint activity with local business support organisations and specific R&D intensive organisations** - manage relations with local actors in the regional “innovation and internationalisation ecosystem”, in order to promote EEN and drive SME traffic to our services;
- **Ensure data integrity and audit transparency in all record keeping**, using relevant CRM and reporting systems, both internally for RTC and in conjunction with other consortium partners;
- Become familiar with the skills of RTC staff, communicate regularly with them and **drive the promotion of RTC Services across the North of England**, thus generating value for the company as a whole.

THE PERSON

The successful candidate is likely to have a degree level (or equivalent) qualification in a Science and Technology, Commercialisation or International Business area but the exact details of their academic background is less relevant than a good working knowledge of business support and the local business support networks.

- Experience of working on European funded projects would be useful but is not a requirement
- Good knowledge of local, national and EU funding and other business support tools
- Well networked with a good understanding of local business support infrastructure and with a wide range of business support specialists and a good reach into the local SME base.
